All schools are required to teach relationships and sexuality education (RSE). Up until now it has been at the discretion of the individual schools in line with their values and ethos. The secretary of state for Northern Ireland is trying to introduce legislation which will make it a statutory requirement for all post primary schools to teach policies including: "early pregnancy prevention and access to abortion".
